The Torah in this week's Parsha commands us to give a Bris Milah to all eight-day old males.

The medrash asks why does the baby have to be circumcised specifically on the eighth day after its birth?

The medrash answers by pointing out that the eight day waiting period was an example of Hashem having mercy on the baby by waiting until it was strong enough to endure this operation.

The Ohr Hachaim Hakadosh asks how do we know that the baby has enough strength after eight days? Also, what is this power that he gets?

The Ohr Hachaim answers based on a Zohar that says that when Hashem created the world it was shaky and not secure.

Even after the six days of creation, the world was in a state of instability.

When the seventh day came - the holy Shabbos - the world became stable and complete.

This is because Shabbos brings with it the Neshama Yeseira (the extra neshama) which gives the world its life.

This is why the baby needs eight days.

It needs to have gone through a Shabbos in which he gets the Neshama Yeseira which will give him the strength and stability he needs to survive a Bris.

No matter what day he is born on, a Shabbos will pass before he is circumcised.

The holy Shabbos has a special power to bestow tranquility and stability upon us and the world. Keeping this concept in mind can transform our outlook on Shabbos completely!

There is a Halacha that a person should forget about his mundane worries and come to Shabbos with a tranquil mindset.

A person has to come with tremendous joy!

However, we often find ourselves super busy and distracted with mundane issues.

We aren't done closing the deal, we may be worried about the logistics of an upcoming trip, we are waiting on an email from someone, etc.

It can be hard to come to Shabbos with the right mindset. How do we do it?

If we realize that Shabbos is the Mekor Kol Habracha - source of all blessing - we will realize that it is foolish to worry about the loose ends before Shabbos.

If we honor Shabbos properly then the deal will get done, the trip will work out, and the email will come through. Not in spite of Shabbos, but because of Shabbos.

Let us all be zocheh to honor Shabbos in this most beautiful way - a joyous spirit and a clear mind.

The Mechina is under the auspices of the
Rosh Yeshiva Rav Yochanan Zweig Shlita

As winter zman draws to an end, the Mechina looks back on a zman of tremendous growth and aliyah. The iyun shiurim covered many of the most complex and in-depth sugyas of Gittin. Many bachurim are also on track to be mesayem the entire Masechtas Gittin. They will be preparing for a thorough and comprehensive bechina on the full masechta.

The Mechina introduced the new Bnei Aliya program, which focuses on a new area of growth every month. Every Rosh Chodesh, an area of Avodas Hashem, such as iyun tefillah, zerizus, etc., is chosen for the entire Mechina. Each Rebbi then tailors the specific message to fit his class, and each participating bochur makes his own kabbalah in discussion with his Rebbi.

The Mechina also had the opportunity to hear divrei hisororus from many visiting Rosh Yeshiva, including Harav Yosef

Eichenstein, the Rosh Yeshiva of Edison Yeshiva, and Rav Yitzchak Ezrachi, the Rosh Yeshiva of Yeshivas, Mir Yerushalayim. The visiting Rosh Yeshiva expressed how they were impressed by the quality of the bachurim and the strong ruach Hatorah of the Mechina.

At the end of February, The Mechina held its annual Shabbos of Chizuk Hatorah on the beautiful Yeshiva campus in New Bloomfield, PA. The Shabbos was one of great ruach and aliya filled with shteiging in learning and uplifting seudas filled with zemiros and divrei Torah.

Over Purim, many of the bachurim took part in the Seudas Purim together with the Rabbeim of the Mechina at the home of the Rosh Mechina, Rabbi Friedman. The seuda reverberated with expressions of Torah and simcha, befitting true bnei Torah.

Alumni Focus

Highlighting the work of Mechina Alumni, where they are now, and how they are impacting the klal.

Shmuel Tenebaum joined the Mechina in 2013 and graduated in 2017. He followed the path of his older brothers Meir and Moshe, who attended the Mechina High School before him and was followed by his brother Yehuda, who joined the Mechina after him. Shmuel's father, Rav Yitzchok Shlit"a is a respected talmid chachom and marbitz Torah in the South Florida community who frequents the Yeshiva Bais Medrash. His mother is a highly respected teacher at Bais Yaakov. Shmuel is married, lives with his wife in Yerushalayim, and learns in the Kollel of Rav Daniel Engel Shlit"a.

MM: Can you give us some background about your time in Mechina and what you are currently doing?

ST: I learned in the Mechina from ninth through twelfth grade. Afterward, I spent one year learning in the Yeshiva's Bais Medrash. I then went to Eretz Yisrael where I learned as a bochur in the Yeshiva of Harav Daniel Engel. After getting married, I returned to the Maalot Dafna area of Yerushalayim and joined the Kollel of Rav Daniel Engel's Yeshiva.

MM: Can you share some reflections on your time at Mechina?

ST: The shiurim in the Mechina were thorough. They delved into the depths of the sugya, yet at the same time, they were clear and understandable. Additionally, the rabbeim were approachable and relatable. Even today, several years after I left the Mechina, I keep a close connection with many of my Rabbeim. I also gained from the intensive bekius program,

which helped me cover much ground and comprehensively understand many mesechtas. The ability to learn with older bachurim in the Yeshiva helped me grow and shteig, and the emphasis on chazarah helped me retain much of what I learned.

MM: Are there any other Mechina memories you would like to recount?

ST: The mussar and hashkafah imparted by the Rabbeim greatly impacted me and how I live as a ben Torah involved in limud haTorah. The Rabbeim in the Mechina made the mussar practical and applicable to daily life situations. The Mechina Summer Program was also a fantastic experience. We had serious sedarim every morning and exciting activities in the afternoon. It also allowed us to develop a kesher and connection with our Rabbeim in a non-classroom setting. Many trips incorporated a ruschniyusdik element, such as our trip to Kennedy Space Center that included a shiur from the Rov in Satellite Beach about how he paskened the shaila about keeping Shabbos in space for Israeli astronaut Ilan Ramon.

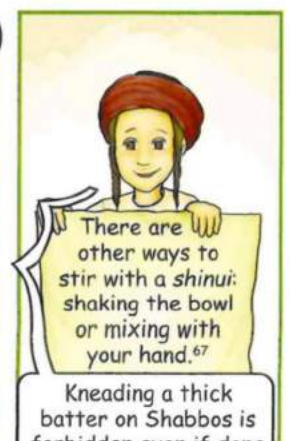
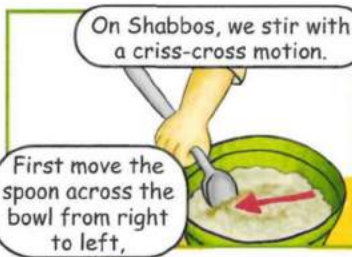
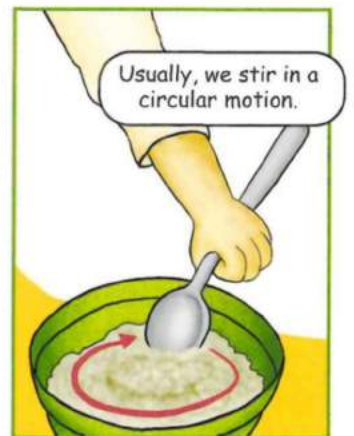
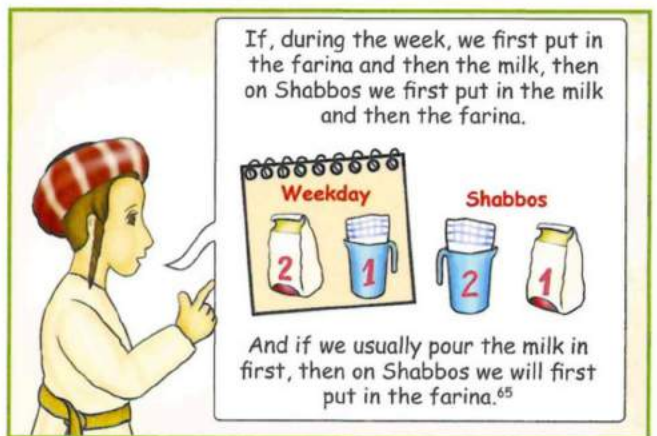
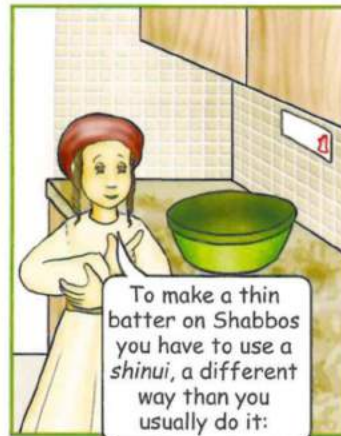


Belilah Rakah - A Thin Batter

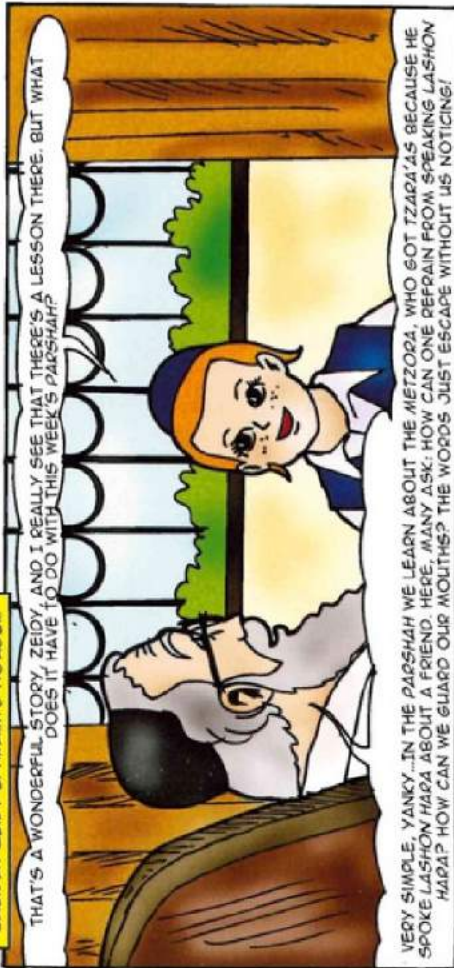

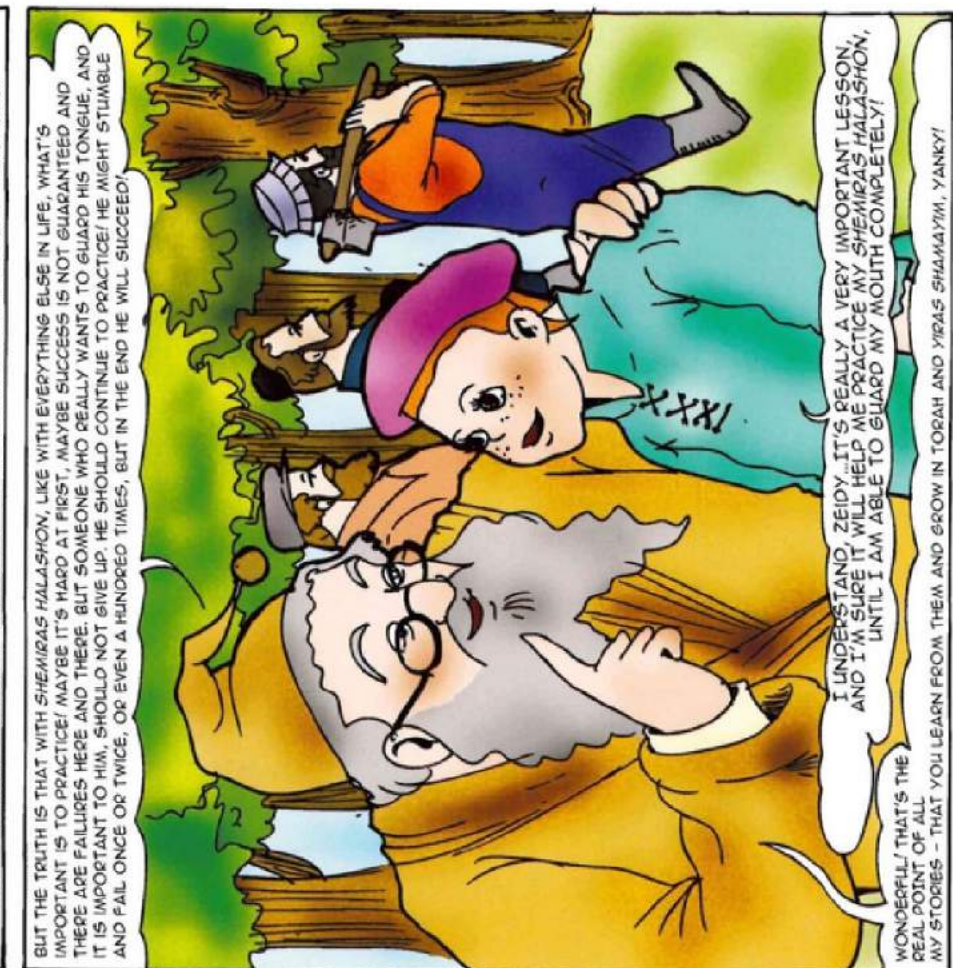
