And they assembled all the congregation together on the first day of the second month, and they declared their lineage after their families, by the houses of their fathers, according to the number of names, from twenty years old and upward, individually (Bamidbar 1:18).

The Parsha opens with Moshe taking a census to count the Jewish People. Immediately preceding the list of each tribe and its population, we find Moshe confirming the tribe-based lineage of each individual.

According to Rashi, every Jewish man was supposed to bring their סְפְרֵי יַחוּסִיהֶם - documentation affirming and validating their membership in their specific שבט tribe.

Why did Moshe require each person to bring documentation to affirm his tribal affiliation? What is the deeper message we can take from this?

The Midrash Yalkut Shemoni tells us another time these סְפְרֵי יַחוּסִיהָם - documents of lineage - were requested.

The Midrash states (paraphrased) at the time that the Jewish Nation was about to receive the Torah, the various nations of the world got jealous and challenged Hashem, asking, "Why did you choose THIS nation to receive the Torah?" Hashem responded, "because they have סְפַרִי and you do not!"

The Midrash is teaching that our entire claim to Torah and our unique connection with Hashem is due to the documentation of our lineage. What is so special about ספרי יחוסיהם?

When we stood at Har Sinai and accepted the Torah, we took upon ourselves the mission to be a moral light unto the nations.

We were destined to teach the world about morality - the intrinsic value of life, the paramount importance of education, the supreme importance of family, and many other values that form the foundation of a healthy and functioning world.

We were charged with the mission of teaching the world that there is One Source of all life and existence, and He created rules, laws, and boundaries to ensure we fill and infuse the world with meaning and values.

In order to play this role, we need to know we come from "yichus" - a refined pedigree - and this reminds us to look to the role models who came before us when shaping our own lives.

The סְּבְרִי יַחוּסִיהָם Hashem required before giving the Torah was meant to remind the Jewish People that in order to know where are are going, we need to know where we come from.

In order to build a moral world, we need to look to the moral role models who preceded us.

Each class from 2nd to 5th came weekly to borrow books.


Some favorite series are Cam Jansen, the Kingdom of Wrenly, the Boxcar Children, and the Baker's Dozen.
